Band Program

Band programs in AVRSB are solely funded through band fees and fundraising. Funds collected through fees and fundraising are used exclusively for instrument expenses (purchases and maintenance), band supplies (reeds, corks, pads, oil, etc.), music, audio equipment, and all other supplies essential to supporting a successful band program.

Many students who participate in band programs are also involved with sports team or other organizations that must also raise funds to meet operating costs. With this in mind, the Central Kings Band Parents Association has created a fee structure that allows us to properly fund the band program and sustain a reasonable fund raising schedule.

All Central Kings band students are required to pay a fee consisting of an instrument rental fee plus a registration fee to cover all other expenses. Band rental fees are common throughout AVRSB and allow us to offer band instruments as an enrichment opportunity within the music curriculum.

Families who are unable to pay the full fee are asked to pay what they can and commit to fundraising the balance. Fees can also be paid with postdated cheques throughout the school year (e.g., ten post-dated \$10.00 cheques).
