OPEN HOUSE

The Open House for all CK students will be held **Thursday, September 10**, at 7:00 p.m. **Grade 12 parents are encouraged to attend a special information meeting at 6:00 p.m. in the cafeteria prior to Open House.** Photographer(s) will share information with you regarding their grad photo packages and draw for a sitting. Jostens will draw for a ring package. **Only Grade 12 students, whose parents/guardians, are at the meeting are eligible for these draws.** Yearbooks orders will be taken for \$40 (regular price \$45)

NOVA SCOTIA GRADUATION REQUIREMENTS

On the first day of school all Grade 12's were given a copy of their academic records to verify that they have registered for enough credits to graduate. **Any student who changes courses or plans to finish at the end of January should verify that they are still eligible to graduate in JUNE.** If your son/daughter attended Grade 10, 11 or 12 at a school other than C.K., please make sure we have those records on file. **NOW** is the time to let us know of any omissions or problems. Even next month could be too late for students to register for essential Graduation credits!!

PARENT VOLUNTEERS

The teachers of the Class of '16 welcome parent help throughout the year and particularly in June. We encourage you to support our fundraisers. Help with organization and clean up at Grad events is greatly appreciated. We will have sign-up lists at Thursday's meeting or you may phone the school and leave your name and number to be included on our lists.

GRAD FEES

To receive the graduation certificate there is no fee. However there is a Grad Fee of \$50.00 for students planning to attend the ceremony. This covers the cost of renting the gowns, purchasing caps and flowers, providing a Class Bursary etc. The fifty dollars (\$50.00) will be due by **MARCH 21, 2016**, otherwise grad gown(s), cap(s) will not be ordered for the student(s) who have not paid.

GRAD PHOTOS OCTOBER Dates TBA(Ms Corbett/Ms Foote)

All students eligible to graduate this year must have their photos taken by Lifetouch. This photo is included in the **composite** photo of the Class of '15 and in the **Yearbook**. No other photo may be substituted for the composite that is prepared by Lifetouch. Students on previous composites do not need to have their photos taken. Photos are taken during school hours and appointment times are made online at www.lifetouch.ca/mygradphotos. **An announcement to students will be made when this site is ready to use.** There is a sitting fee. Sitting fee appointments will be scheduled first, followed by the appointments of the remaining grads. Appointment times are booked on-line. **Sitting fees range from \$15-\$25...see handout from Lifetouch, or on their website www.lifetouch.ca/mygradphotos**

Grad Photo packages are available from other photographers. Most of our local photographers have been supplied with our cap and collar. Please verify that the photographer has the cap and collar and a gown in case you need to bring your own. Grad gowns may be rented from Acadia Bookstore (902) 585-1201 for a fee. If students need to borrow a cap and collar, please contact the school. **There will be a \$10.00 fee, fully refundable, upon return of the borrowed items.**

GRAD RINGS

Ring Day has been set for September 11 and 14th. A down payment of \$50.00 is required before a ring will be ordered. The rings will arrive before Christmas break. Our Grad ring may also be ordered from most of the local jewelers.

GRAD GEAR

Grad gear will be available through our Campus Store. These will be available at parent visitation on November 26th. T-shirts, sweat shirts/pants etc. make excellent Christmas gifts.

GRADE 12 Information for Post secondary plans (Ms. Keddy)

The Grade 12 Counselor (Ms Keddy) met with the grade 12 students to share information with the Grads about transcripts, reference letters, applications, scholarships, etc. **It is essential that students follow procedures outlined by the Counselor when sending transcripts to post secondary institutions.**

Education Expo October 6th (Ms Keddy)

Approximately 35 institutions from the Atlantic Provinces will be at Central Kings to provide information and material to students on a variety of post secondary education options. Parent/guardians are welcome to attend this event. Throughout the year several post secondary institutions will organize dates to meet interested students.
